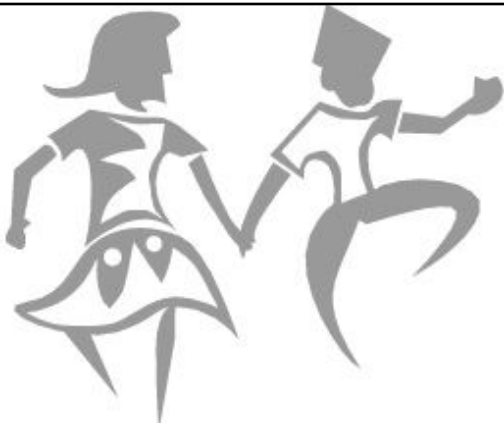

The workshop will run 4:30 to 6. We will then break for a potluck dinner before our regularly scheduled dance that night.

## Interested in dancing all week?

Cumberland Dance Week (July 25 - 31, 2004) is a labor of love created and managed by the volunteers of the Lloyd Shaw Foundation. Our goal has always been to create a week which celebrates the American folk tradition through dance, song, and music. We've been able to offer the talents of callers such as Glen Morningstar, Chris Bischoff, Seth Tepfer, Bill Litchman, and Kathy Anderson, along with a cast of terrific musicians.

Over the many years of doing this we have found that most new people come to our week because they live in the same town as other people who have come. Once someone comes from a dance group in a town, other people follow next year.

Nobody comes to Cumberland Dance Week from Huntsville. We'd like to change that, because we know that will mean more people next year.

So, to plant that seed, Cumberland Dance Week is offering a "one time only" discounted rate for the first individual, couple, or family from Huntsville of \$350 per adult, \$125 per teen (12-17), \$75 per child (6-11), and \$25 per tot (0-5).

This is essentially our room and board cost - CDW will not recoup anything to pay for staff from you this year. This offer is extended to a few other dance groups in a handful of cities. We reserve the right to stop it if it is TOO successful, for the simple reason that the Kentucky Leadership Center only has so many rooms and we can't sell out the week to people from new cities and have no space for the regular faithful guests that allow us to pay the bills.

### Tips for a great Blue Moon:

Be hospitable, keep an eye on dancers who are sitting out & ask them to dance.

Join the shortest line. Join at the bottom of the set. Take hands-four BEFORE you are asked by the caller (don't worry about proper or improper until prompted.)

If a dance doesn't go perfectly, smile anyway - it's just a dance. After each dance, thank your partner and applaud the band & caller. Enjoy yourself - it'll be a great weekend!
